
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Brief Introduction of Resource Person:

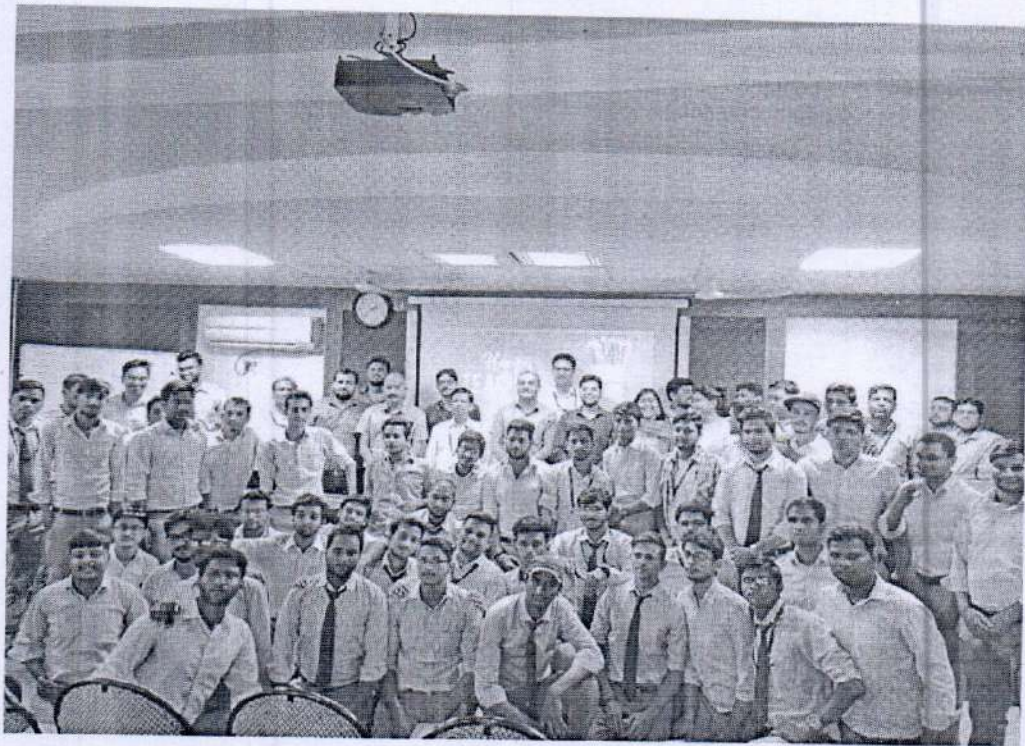
Objective: ITS Engineering College celebrated the Teacher's Day which was organised by Mechanical Engineering Deptt. on 5th Sept.2019


The festival is primarily celebrated in factories and industrial areas, as well a shops.

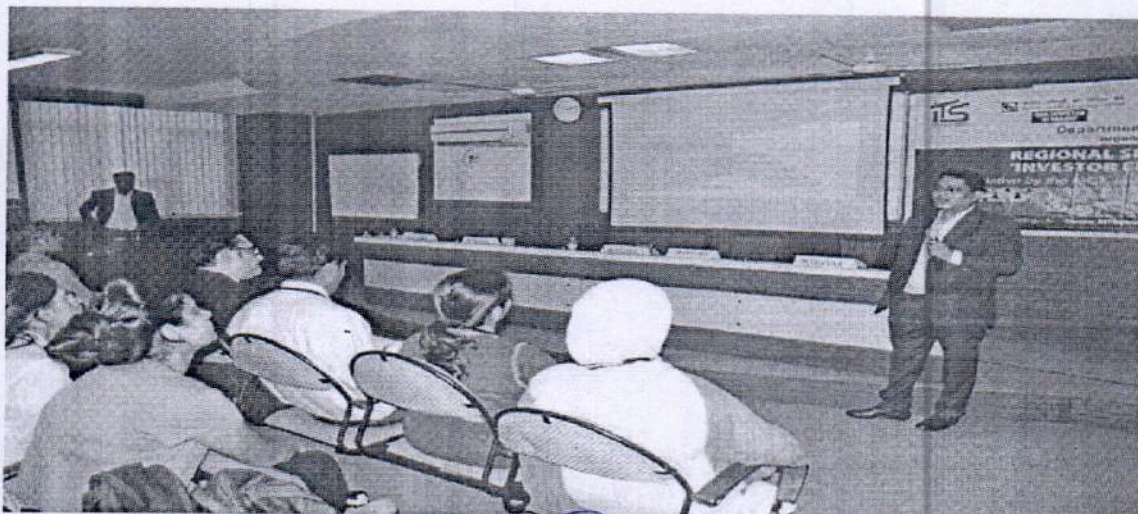




Objective:


The celebration started with a welcome address by Prof. (Dr.) Monika Jain, Head, Dept. of EEE, & IEEE PES Chapter Counsellor

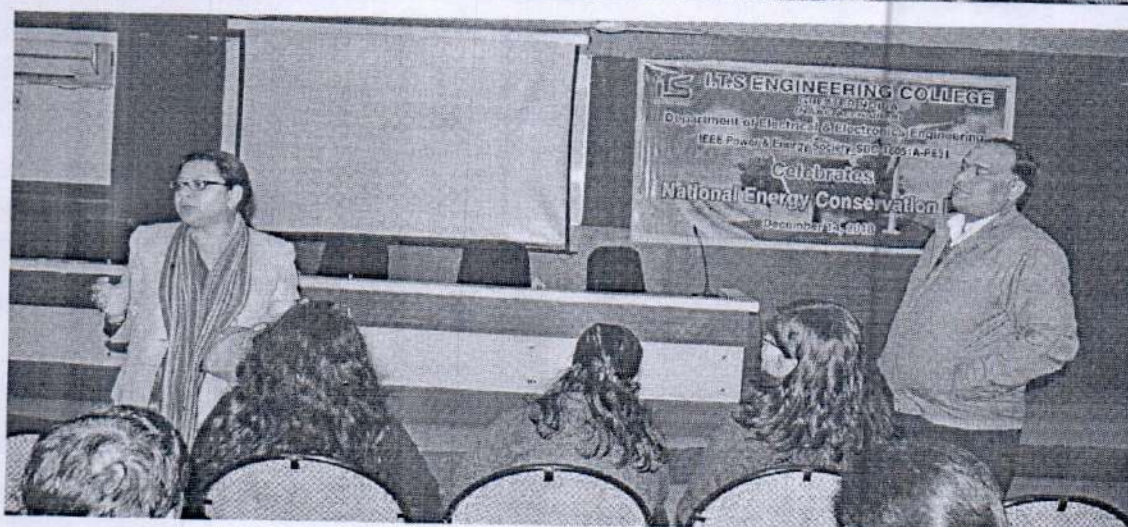
