4. The expenditure shall be incurred towards technology fee, telephone, fax, computer facility etc, machinery hiring or on lease or by use of common facilities provided in the premises, guidance fee for the hand holding person, electricity and accommodation charges etc. The main activities includes nurturing of innovative business ideas (new/ingenious technology, processes, products, procedures, etc.), with the expected outcome of it being commercialized into an enterprise.

5. The terms and conditions governing the grant will be as per agreement executed between Government and the to the ITS Engineering College, Ghaziabad, U.P. The amount released as first installment will be utilized within a period of six month. The funds shall be released only when host institution confirms that each Incubatee has deposited 30% of their share towards project cost The balance amount will be released in one or more installments once the HOST INSTITUTION/BUSINESS INCUBATOR has utilized the earlier amount and submitted the utilization certificate in GFR Form 19A under the provision of GFR -2005 duly certified by the authorized signatory. In case of misutilisation or diversion of grant sanctioned under the scheme, the incubator shall be liable to refund to the president of India the whole or a part amount of the grant with interest @ of 10 % per annum thereon.

6. The time limit for commercialization of ideas through incubator is preferably one year until and unless some valid justification is given for extension of the time limit. The Executive Head shall submit Quarterly/Six monthly Progress Report of the Business Incubator to this office. The consolidated report on the final outcome of such incubation along with the report of mentor/guide about the quality of the work done, its cost effectiveness, tangible gains (quantitative) likely to be achieved, etc., is also to be submitted within 3 months of the completion of the work.







Minutes of Meeting of 7th Project Monitoring & Advisory Committee (PMAC) Meeting of MSME Innovative Scheme (a component under MSME Champions Scheme) under the Chairmanship of AS & DC (MSME)

The 7th Project Monitoring & Advisory Committee (PMAC) meeting was held under the Chairmanship of AS & DC (MSME) on 15.02.2024 at 4:00 PM through Hybrid Mode (Physical/VC) of "MSME Innovative Scheme", a component under MSME Champions Scheme. *The list of participants is at Annexure-I.*

2. Shri Ateesh Singh, JS (AFI), Ministry of MSME welcomed the members and appraised the members about the agenda of the meeting through a PPT, including guidelines of MSME Innovative Scheme emphasizing the financial assistance under this scheme and approvals required under Incubation component.
3. Shri V. Ramakrishnan, Deputy Director, O/o DC MSME appraised the committee about the various steps undertaken for inviting and shortlisting top-ranking ideas under MSME Idea Hackathon 3.0 (Women) – Sector wise which was launched on 27th June 2023 by the Hon'ble Union minister for MSME. Ideas were invited under this Hackathon from women Innovators and women owned MSMEs from all over India.
4. The ideas were received from women innovators only through MIS portal <https://innovative.msme.gov.in> for MSME Idea Hackathon 3.0 (Women) under 5 sectors i.e., Agriculture, Healthcare, Power, Services and Miscellaneous. A total of 18,888 ideas were received, out of which 7519 ideas were shortlisted and uploaded by Host Institutes (HIs) and subsequently 5676 ideas were forwarded to the Domain Expert Selection Committee (DESCs) for evaluation. After detailed evaluation by respective Sector-wise DESCs, 680 top ideas @ 10% from each sector were filtered. Out of 680 ideas, 397 top ideas were shortlisted and placed before the PMAC for approval after following the selection of ideas criteria & process.
5. JS (AFI), MoMSME) initiated detailed discussion on the ideas and sought opinion from the PMAC members regarding the selection criteria for shortlisting the ideas. Thereafter, a detailed deliberation was held among the members including Domain experts and there was a consensus that the filtration and selection process were both transparent and appropriately done. The members also expressed satisfaction regarding the transparency adopted throughout the selection process.


