# Policy on Sexual Harassment of Employees at Workplace

#### POLICY

1.1The I.T.S Engineering College is an equal employmentopportunity organization and is committed to create a healthy workingenvironment that enables employees to work without fear of prejudice, gender bias and sexual harassment. The Organization also believes that allemployees of the institute have the right to be treated with dignity. Sexual harassment at the work place if involvingemployees is a grave offence and is, therefore, punishable.

1.2The Supreme Court has also directed organizations to lay down guidelinesand a forum for redressal of grievances related to sexual harassment.

In accordance with the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013, the Institute has framed an **Internal Complaint Committee of I.T.S Engineering College for**thePrevention of Sexual Harassment at Workplace and adopted the same w.e.f20 June 2014. Vide notification dated 9th December2013; Ministry of Women and Child Development have introduced Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Rules, 2013.

#### Scope & Effective

This policy applies to all categories of employees of the Organization, including permanent management and workmen, temporaries and employees on contract at its workplace or at client sites.

# Sexual harassment would mean and include any of the following:

 i) Unwelcome sexual advances, requests or demand for sexual favours, either explicitly or implicitly, in return for employment, promotion, examination or evaluation of a person towards any company activity;

ii) unwelcome sexual advances involving verbal, non-verbal, or physicalconduct such as sexually colored remarks, jokes, letters, phone calls,e-mail, gestures, showing of pornography, lurid stares, physical contactor molestation, stalking, sounds, display of pictures, signs, verbal or Non-verbal communication which offends the individual's sensibilities and affect her/his performance;

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- iii) Eve teasing, innuendos and taunts, physical confinement against one'swill and likely to intrude upon one's privacy;
- iv) act or conduct by a person in authority which creates the environmentat workplace hostile or intimidating to a person belonging to the other

#### Complaint redressal committee:

The College has instituted an Internal Complaints Committee for redressal of sexual harassment complaint (made by the victim) and for ensuring time bound treatment of such complaints. In accordance with the sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013, the Internal Complaints Committee will comprise of the following:

- 1. Presiding officer- Shall be a woman employed at a senior level at workplace amongst the employees
  - 2. Members (Not less than 2)- Shall be amongst employees preferably committed to the cause of woman.
  - 3. One External Member amongst Non-Governmental Organizations or associations committed to cause of woman

# The Internal Complaints Committee is responsible for:

- Investigating every formal written complaint of sexual harassment.
- Taking appropriate remedial measures to respond to any substantiated allegations of sexual harassment.
- Discouraging and preventing employment-related sexual harassment.

# REDRESSAL PROCEDURES FOR RESOLUTION, SETTLEMENT OR PROSECUTION OF ACTS OF SEXUAL HARASSMENT:

The College is committed to providing a supportive environment in which the concerns of sexual harassment shall be resolved as follows:

#### A. Informal Resolution Options

- 1. When an incident of sexual harassment occurs, the victim of such conduct can communicate her disapproval and objections immediately to the harasser and request the harasser to behave decently.
- 2. If the harassment does not stop or if victim is not comfortable with addressing the harasser directly, she can bring her concern to the attention of the Internal Complaints Committee for redressal of her grievances. The Internal Complaints Committee will thereafter provide advice or extend support as requested and will undertake prompt investigation to resolve the matter.

#### B. Complaints:

- 1. Any employee with a harassment concern, who is not comfortable with the informal resolution options or has exhausted such options, may make a formal complaint to the Chairperson of the Internal Complaints Committee constituted by the Management.
- 2. The complainant shall submit the complaint in writing to the Complaint Committee along with supporting documents and the names and addresses of the witnesses in writing and can be in form of a letter, preferably within 3months from the date of occurrence of the alleged incident, sent in a sealed envelope. Alternately, the employee can send complaint through an email. The employee is

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required to disclose her name, department, division and location she is working in, to enable the Chairperson to contact her and take the matter forward.

- 3. The Complaint Committee shall send 1(one) of the copies received from the aggrieved woman to the accused (respondent) within a period of 7 working days.
- 4. The Accused (respondent) shall file his reply to the Complaint along with supporting documents and the names and addresses of the witnesses, within a period not exceeding 10 working days from the date of receipt of the documents.
- 5. The Complaint committee have the right to terminate the inquiry proceedings or to give an exparte decision on the complaint, if the Aggrieved (complainant) or Accused (respondent) fails, without sufficient cause, to present herself or himself for 3 consecutive hearings convened by the Chairperson, as the case may be, provided that such termination or ex-parte order may not be passed without giving a notice in writing, 15 days in advance, to the party concerned.

In conducting the inquiry, a minimum of 3 Members of the Complaints Committee including the chairperson, as the case may be, shall be present.

- 6. The parties shall not be allowed to bring in any legal practitioner to represent them in their case at any stage of the proceedings before the Complaints Committee.
- 7. The Internal Complaints Committee shall conduct such investigations in a timely manner and shall submit a written report containing the findings and recommendations to the Employer as soon as practically possible and in any case, not later than 10 days from the date of completion of inquiry. The Employer shall act upon the recommendation within 60 days of its receipt by him.
- 8. The Complaint's Committee report will also be made available to concerned parties.

#### MANNER OF TAKING ACTION AGAINST THE RESPONDENT:

Where the Complaints Committee arrives at the conclusion that the allegation against the respondents been proved, it shall recommend to the employer to take action which may include the following:

- a. Written apology;
- b. Warning;
- c. Reprimand or Censure;
- d. Withholding of Promotion;
- e. Withholding of pay rise or increments; or
- f. Terminating the respondent from service; or
- g. Undergoing a counseling session or carrying out community service.

#### CONFIDENTIALITY:

The College understands that it is difficult for the victim to come forward with a complaint of sexual harassment and recognizes the victim's interest in keeping the matter confidential.

To protect the interests of the victim, the accused person and others who may report incidents of sexual harassment, confidentiality will be maintained throughout any investigatory process to the extent practicable and appropriate under the circumstances.

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### PROTECTION TO COMPLAINANT / VICTIM:

- The College is committed to ensuring that no employee who brings forward a harassment concern is subject to any form of reprisal. Any reprisal will be subject to disciplinary action.
- The College will ensure that victim or witnesses are not victimized or discriminated against
  while dealing with complaints of sexual harassment.
- However, anyone who abuses the procedure (for example, by maliciously putting an allegation knowing it to be untrue) will be subject to disciplinary action.

# DUTIES OF INTERNAL COMPLAINT COMMITTEE OF I.T.S ENGINEERING COLLEGE:

- Provide a safe working environment (i.e. provide its women employees, a workplace, free from harassment/ discrimination and every employee is treated with dignity and respect).
- Display conspicuously at the workplace, the penal consequences of indulging in acts that
  may constitute sexual harassment and the composition of the Internal Complaints
  Committee
- Organize workshops and awareness programmes at regular intervals for sensitizing employees on the issues and implications of workplace sexual harassment and organizing orientation programmes for members of the Internal Complaints Committee

#### CONCLUSION:

In conclusion, the Institute reiterates its commitment to providing its women employees, a
workplace free from harassment/ discrimination and where every employee is treated with
dignity and respect.


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# Online Oath ceremony of male students for special campaign for participation & safety of women & girls
