



The event was started with welcome note delivered by Dr. Akhilesh Kumar Mishra, HOD MBA, SOMS,ITSEC Greater Noida. The Resource Person Prof. Arjun J. Chaudhuri (Advocate and Corporate Consultant) started his talk with introduction of Patents, Designs, Trade Marks and Geographical Indications and then discussed the topics in detail. He explained that patents are exclusive privilege / rights granted by Government to the patentee for 20 years from date of filing / priority for commercial gain in consideration of full disclosure of his/ her invention as a Territorial Right & not worldwide. The industrial design recognizes the creation of the new and original features of new shape, configuration, surface pattern, ornamentations and compositions of lines or colours applied to articles which in the finished state appeal to and are judged solely by the eye. The Trade Marks Registry was established in India in 1940 and presently it administers the Trade Marks Act, 1999 and the rules there under. It acts as a resource

and information centre and is a facilitator in matters relating to trade marks in the country. The objective of the Trade Marks Act, 1999 is to register trademarks applied for in the country and to provide for better protection of trade mark for goods and services and also to prevent fraudulent use of the mark. The main function of the Registry is to register trademarks which qualify for registration under the Act and Rules. Geographical Indications of Goods are defined as that aspect of industrial property which refer to the geographical indication referring to a country or to a place situated therein as being the country or place of origin of that product.

Dr. Rajiv Ranjan, IIC Convener, ITSEC concluded the event and gave the vote of thanks.

The event was started with a welcome address by Dr.Rajiv Ranjan, Convener- IIC ITSEC. The resource person Mr. Ashish Gupta, CEO & FOUNDER, SWATVAH Pvt. Limited, discussed the process of innovation development, technology readiness level (TRL), commercialization of lab technologies & tech-transfer. The Speaker started with the concept of TRLs which can allow engineers to have an understanding of readiness for a particular technology, its evolution, scope, and how to achieve top level regardless of their technical background. He explained the TRLs measure of maturity level of a technology throughout its research, development and deployment phase progression. He further explained about the scaling-based system from 1 to 9, with 9 being the most mature technology.









He stated that Manufacturing readiness and technology readiness go hand-in-hand. MRLs, in conjunction with Technology Readiness Levels (TRL), are key measures that define risk when technology or process is matured and transitioned to a system. It is quite common for manufacturing readiness to be paced by technology readiness or design stability. Manufacturing processes will not be able to mature until the product technology and product designs are stable

Learning Outcome:

Attendees gained knowledge in the following areas:

- · How Scientific Observations are made and reported in Technology Readiness level
- How Practical application is involved in TRL, MRL and IRL
- Risk analysis and various implications involved in the TRL

Conclusion: Attendees got a lot of technical inputs on Technology Readiness Levels and understood how to assess the maturity of a given technology, system, subsystem, or component, from a manufacturing perspective.







He described the meaning of the solution fit product as solution to a problem with customer specific approach not as money making approach, He illustrated, that the first stem is identifying the problem and then the customer should be identified which may have usual buying behavior not willing to change the buying approach or new buying behavior, willing to try new products and sometimes the usual consumers are forced to adopt to the new solutions. Right solution fit is required to meet all types of consumers. He further stated that consumers these days are open to adopt change and try new solutions and therefore nowadays understanding the consumers habit and be transparency in communication; the more is transparency better would be the solution fit product. He illustrated that the more an entrepreneur thinks as a customer for a solution, better fit would be the solution and its success. He defined as product fit not only as a product which is accepted but also

is retained. An entrepreneur always test the product and do refinements to make it market fit product and enhance the product to make it accepted and retained. Production can be done by systematic manner. Open and quicker approach is required for iteration. He explained that business model and plan are different. He suggested that adopting segregation at each step, for example at identification of problem, action plans, and solutions would help the entrepreneur to develop a market fit product.







Ms Prateeti started her talk with introduction of Patents, Designs, Trade Marks and Geographical Indications and then discussed the topics in detail. She explained that patents are exclusive privilege / rights granted by Government to the patentee for 20 years from date of filing / priority for commercial gain in consideration of full disclosure of his/ her invention as a Territorial Right & not worldwide. The industrial design recognizes the creation of

the new and original features of new shape, configuration, surface pattern, ornamentations and compositions of lines or colours applied to articles which in the finished state appeal to and are judged solely by the eye. The Trade Marks Registry was established in India in 1940 and presently it administers the Trade Marks Act, 1999 and the rules there under. It acts as a resource and information centre and is a facilitator in matters relating to trade marks in the country. The objective of the Trade Marks Act, 1999 is to register trademarks applied for in the country and to provide for better protection of trade mark for goods and services and also to prevent fraudulent use of the mark. The main function of the Registry is to register trademarks which qualify for registration under the Act and Rules. Geographical Indications of Goods are defined as that aspect of industrial property which refer to the geographical indication referring to a country or to a place situated therein as being the country or place of origin of that product. Typically, such a name conveys an assurance of quality and distinctiveness which is essentially attributable to the fact of its origin in that defined geographical locality, region or country. Under Articles 1 (2) and 10 of the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, geographical indications are covered as an element of IPRs. They are also covered under Articles 22 to 24 of the Trade Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights (TRIPS) Agreement. The event was concluded with vote of thanks by Dr. Rajiv Ranjan.
